The parties hereby have agreed as follows:

Partnership Agreement – The main points

- This Agreement defines the terms that govern the relations between the parties, by establishing their rights and obligations, and lays down the rules of procedure for the work to be carried out in order to successfully implement the Erasmus+ project.
- The main coordinator and the other partner schools, undertake to do everything in their power to carry out the work programme forming the subject of this Agreement, which falls within the framework of the Erasmus+ Project Grant Agreement.
- The subject matter of this Agreement and the related work programme are detailed below. The respective Grant Agreement terms and conditions shall form an integral part of the present Agreement.
- The coordinator and the partner schools shall be bound by the terms and conditions of this Agreement.
- The working language of the project shall be English.
- The dates of the meetings will be mutually decided.
- This Agreement shall enter into force since the date of the project approval and will last for 2 years according to the period of eligibility and shall remain in force until the coordinator has been discharged in full of his/her obligations arising from the Grant Agreement signed with the Executive Agency.
- The project agenda and division of responsibilities shall be established by all the partners mutually.

- In case of any conflict between the partners resulting from the interpretation or the application of the project, or in connection with the activities contained within, the parties involved shall make the effort to come to an amicable arrangement rapidly and in the spirit of good cooperation.

The main coordinator shall:

- be responsible for the overall coordination, management and implementation of the project in accordance with the Grant Agreement of the Erasmus+ project.
- be responsible for complying with any legal obligations incumbent on them jointly or individually.
- be the intermediary for all communication between the partner schools and the Executive Agency.

The partner schools shall:

- inform the coordinator immediately of any change likely to affect or delay the implementation of the action.
- provide the coordinator with all the information or documents it may require and which are necessary for the management of the project in time
- provide information, documents and supporting documents necessary for progress report and final report
- participate at scheduled meetings.
- avoid any situation that may lead to conflict of interest during implementation of the project and duration of the Grant Agreement.
